## VENUE: BUSINESS DESIGN CENTRE

The Business Design Centre in Islington is one of London's most iconic exhibition venues. Offering 6,000 m<sup>2</sup> of naturally lit event space, the BDC provides an inspiring backdrop for showcasing your latest collections.

Located just minutes from King's Cross St Pancras and central London, the venue is easily accessible for both UK and international visitors.

An on-site Hilton hotel and dedicated parking ensure a seamless experience for exhibitors and guests alike.

# EXHIBITOR TERMS & CONDITIONS

## 1. Booking and Payment

Exhibition space is confirmed upon submission of a completed booking form and payment in accordance with the invoice terms. All fees must be settled prior to the event.

## 2. Cancellation and Deferral

Exhibitors may cancel their participation up to 30 days before the event with no penalty. Cancellations received within 30 days of the event are subject to a cancellation fee of 50% of the total stand cost.

All cancellations must be submitted in writing to the organisers.

Requests to defer participation to a future edition may be considered on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the organisers.

## 3. Stand Use and Presentation

All displays and materials must remain within the boundaries of the allocated stand space.

Aisles and access routes must be kept clear at all times.

Pull-up banners or similar freestanding advertising displays are strictly prohibited.

The organisers reserve the right to remove any non-compliant items.

## 4. Content Standards

Exhibitors must not display political messages, flags, or material that may be considered offensive, inappropriate, or disruptive.

The organisers' decision on the suitability of stand content is final.

## 5. Code of Conduct

Exhibitors and their representatives are expected to conduct themselves professionally at all times.

Verbal or physical abuse toward staff, organisers, or other participants will not be tolerated.

The organisers reserve the right to remove offenders from the venue and to refuse participation in future editions.

## **6. Insurance and Liability**

Exhibitors are required to hold adequate public liability insurance and insurance for their property, goods in transit, and business activities.

The organisers and venue accept no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to exhibitor property. Except where not permitted by law, the organisers' liability to any exhibitor is limited to the stand fees paid for the current edition.

## **7. Visa Support**

Invitation letters for visa purposes may be provided once a booking has been confirmed.

Exhibitors are responsible for submitting visa applications within sufficient time to allow processing.

Refunds for exhibitors denied a visa may be considered on a case-by-case basis, subject to the provision of official proof of refusal and evidence that the application was made within an appropriate timeframe. No guarantee of refund is given.

## **8. Photography and Filming**

The organisers may photograph and film the event for marketing and documentation purposes.

By participating, exhibitors consent to the reasonable use of images or recordings that may incidentally feature their stand or staff.

## **9. Data Protection**

The organisers will process exhibitor details solely for the administration and promotion of the event, in line with the published Privacy Notice.

Exhibitors collecting personal information from attendees are responsible for their own data protection compliance.

## **10. Force Majeure**

The organisers are not liable for cancellation, postponement, or curtailment of the event due to circumstances beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to natural disasters, strikes, government restrictions, or acts of terrorism.

## **11. Governing Law**

These terms are governed by the laws of England and Wales, with exclusive jurisdiction belonging to the courts of England and Wales.
